Hinemoa Elder chose to pursue a career in Medicine after working in the arts and television after her mother developed breast cancer and passed away. She could see a critical need for Maori Doctors working with whanau.

She developed a way for health workers who are working with Maori whanau with traumatic brain injuries to measure cultural needs, a theory and practice which can withstand critique from Te Ao Māori and western science. What she has developed will likely help in wider fields such as mental health and addictions.
