Wendy Dixon is well known throughout New Zealand and Australia in opera, concert and recital music. She has sung as a guest artist soprano soloist with Opera in Australia, New Zealand, Singapore and Mexico, and has toured with Musica Viva and for the Chamber Music Federation of New Zealand.

She has created her Voice Trek series (group classes for adult beginners) and for several years at Christmas wrote and ran 'Lets Make an Opera' for Ku-ring-gai Council, a week-long course for children that incorporates acting, singing and costume-making with a performance at the completion.

She has completed a Masters in Music Education at Conservatorium of Music, University of Sydney. Wendy is also the founder of Sydney Art Song Society Inc, a group for mature age amateur singers giving performance opportunities within a supportive and educational atmosphere.

Wendy is the producer and artistic director of Opera BootCamp Australia, a programme that encourages and teaches 14-20 year old potential opera singers.
